

# CANINE PREVENTATIVE HEALTH GUIDELINES

**Your pet's health is important, no matter their age. Preventive health guidelines offer a great base for your pet's healthcare needs and can help you prepare for what vaccines and diagnostics may be recommended at your next visit.**

- Age 0 - 1: 8, 12, 16 week exams & vaccines: spay/neuter
- Age 1: Preventative health examination, Dalp (Distemper/Adenovirus/Leptospirosis/Parvovirus), Rabies, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Prep Profile bloodwork
- Age 2 - 3: Preventative health examination, Leptospirosis, Bordetella vaccines
- Age 4: Preventative health examination, Dalp, Rabies, Bordetella vaccines
- Age 5 - 6: Preventative health examination, Leptospirosis, Bordetella vaccines
- Age 7: Preventative health examination, Dalp, Rabies, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive bloodwork
- Age 8 - 9: Preventative health examination, Leptospirosis, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive/Thyroid bloodwork, Urinalysis
- Age 10: Preventative health examination, Dalp, Rabies, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive bloodwork, Urinalysis (Possible Thyroid bloodwork)
- Age 11 - 12: Preventative health examination, Leptospirosis, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive bloodwork, Urinalysis, 2 view chest and abdomen radiographs, (Possible Thyroid bloodwork)
- Age 13: Preventative health examination, Dalp, Rabies, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive bloodwork, Urinalysis, 2 view chest and abdomen radiographs, (Possible Thyroid bloodwork)
- Age 14+: Preventative health examination, Leptospirosis, Bordetella vaccines, CBC/Comprehensive bloodwork, Urinalysis, 2 view chest and abdomen radiographs, (Possible Thyroid bloodwork)
